

# Privacy Policy

QED/inc. respects your privacy and recognizes the importance of protecting information collected from you through QED/inc.'s Web site, related data, and/or related services (collectively, the "Services"). QED/inc. ("we" or "us") will comply with this policy, and applicable privacy-related law, when we gather and use information from users of the Services. Simply put:

- \* We will not collect Personal Information without your knowledge and permission;
- \* We will not knowingly disclose your Personal Information to third parties, except as provided in this Privacy Policy or with your specific permission;
- \* We will allow you to view, correct or remove your Personal Information; and
- \* We will take reasonable steps to protect the security of the Personal Information we collect from you.

This policy is current as of its last revision date below. However, please note that this policy may be amended by us from time to time to reflect changes and additions to the privacy policy. You should check back for the most current version before relying on any of the provisions in this privacy policy.

## Collection of Information

QED/inc. collects a variety of information relating to usage of the Services.

\* Information you provide. You may provide us information about yourself, such as providing your e-mail address so we can send you information about the Services, or sending us e-mail. We use this information to respond to your requests, and to provide and improve the Services. We may combine this information with other information we collect from the Services or from other companies.

\* Usage logs. When you access the Services, your computer communicates a variety of information to computer servers operating the Services, including the existence of cookies, your Internet Protocol address, and information about your browser program. Your usage may also create a record of what information you are requesting from the Services.

## Usage and Disclosure

In general, QED/inc. uses the information collected to provide the Services and to communicate with you.

We will only share personal information in the following circumstances:

- \* Consent. When you consent or direct QED/inc. to share the information.
- \* Legal Obligation or Protection from Harm. When QED/inc. has a good faith belief that

access, use, preservation or disclosure of the personal information is reasonably necessary to (a) satisfy any requirement of law, regulation, legal process, or enforceable governmental request, (b) enforce or investigate a potential violation of the Terms of Use, (c) detect, prevent, or otherwise respond to fraud, security or technical concerns, or (d) protect the rights, property, or safety of QED/inc., its users, or the public against harm.

\* Merger or sale. When and if QED/inc. is involved in a merger, acquisition, or any form of sale of some or all of its business, personal information may be transferred along with the business.

### Storage and Security of Information

Personal information will be processed and stored by QED/inc. in databases hosted in the United States.
